Hundreds Turn Out To Make

United Way's Day-of-Caring a Success

Pearl River, NY – October 5, 2010 – Over 200 volunteers from twenty different organizations took the day off from their jobs to complete twenty community service projects across Rockland County during this year's Day-of-Caring event.

In the words of one volunteer, "We do it because we care about each other. That's just the spirit of Rockland County," explained Rose Keaveney, Financial Service Representative at Palisades Federal Credit Union.

Activities to mark the 17th annual, United Way of Rockland County's Day-of-Caring, kicked off in the morning and lasted until five in the evening. Beginning at 8:30 a.m., the volunteers gathered for a breakfast at the IBM Palisades Center to kick off the work day before they dispersed to tackle various projects throughout the County.

The service activities included the restoration of the historical Bath House located at Nyack Beach State Park, clean up of the Minisceongo Creek, and general gardening, landscaping, trail preservation, and painting projects for various non-profit organizations.

"We've been participating in this event for years and we're delighted to have had the opportunity to increase this year's monetary contribution despite the current economic climate," said Mark Welshoff, President & CEO of Palisades Federal Credit Union. "We take our hats off to the United Way for executing another successful event and continuing to support our community."

A number of locally based organizations like Palisades Federal Credit Union, allowed their employees to volunteer for the day, in lieu of reporting to their ongoing assignment. The students volunteered to assist those non-profit agencies whose schedules conflicted with the official Day-of-Caring.
